All Americanism Reports **MUST** have a completed Department of Tennessee Americanism Questionnaire and Criteria Form in the front of the (Book or Album). The judging will consider **ONLY** this form in their evaluation of the Americanism Awards.

History and Photos in the album should be limited to the events during the judged year only.

All items checked on the Questionnaire and Criteria Form must be supported by documentation in the book. Items that may be used for the documentation may include, but not be limited to, photographs, newspaper articles, programs of events, or letters from supported organizations. Use appropriate captions (names, occasions, etc.) to relate photos with Questionnaire activities.

The Americanism Award is the most distinguished award the winning Detachment can obtain that shows their hard work and Esprit de Corps. As the "Marine of the Year" is the **most** prestigious award for an individual member, so is an Americanism Award for the Detachment. It exemplifies the dedication and contribution to the strength and integrity of our beloved Marine Corps League and is dedicated to all the members of the winning Detachment. To have received this award is certainly an achievement to be proudly treasured by the recipients of this honorable recognition.
